TRAVELS

- Remember to inform Finnish contingent about your travel plans, roverway2024@partio.fi
 - Norway needs this information to organize shuttlebuses 2.8.2024
- Travel (if possible) with your patrol or IST buddies
- Use entur.no to find connection in Norway
 - New connections open all the time, so keep an eye on the website
- Contact your path leader if you have any problems finding connections to the path entry point

PATHS AND CAMPLIFE

- Path leaders provide all the information about paths
- There should be about 50 people on each path. This group will be called *Tropp*
- Camp program:
 - Main program with tropp and patrol
 - Side programme is optional

SAFETY

- Remember to read Safety instructions that were send to you with the latest newsletter
 - Download the instructions to your phone or print them
 - Some main points:
 - Keep your most valuable belongings with you
 - The camp program does not include swimming. There are swimming places on the campsite and swimming is possible at your own risk. If you go swimming take a friend with you!
 - It is recommended to get European Health insurance Card
 - Download Hjelp 113 GPS app. (More information in the safety instructions.)
 - The most important phone numbers: take them with you on the paper.
 - Copy your passport or identity card and keep it separate from the original. If they get lost/stolen, contact police and embassy.
 - If your bank/credit card gets lost/stolen, cancel it immediately
- Safe from harm -course, we will inform you when it is available.

- Travel insurance
